The readings from last weekend's Gospel once again provide us with guidance and direction in our lives. Sr Liz reminded us that the people who are the most memorable are not the most famous or powerful, but those who have been kind and loving. Jesus teaches us that in the Kingdom of God it is about giving, not receiving. "How can I do things for others, rather than what can I get."



This week there are two significant Feast Days. Tuesday 6th August is the Transfiguration of the Lord. This feast celebrates Jesus as being both divine and human as well as the glory of God which shines forth in the lives of Christians.



Thursday 8th August we celebrate St Mary of the Cross. Mary MacKillop is Australia's first saint. Mary and her religious sisters supported families living in isolation and provided education for their children.



Students in M3 continue their preparation to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on Sunday 18th August. Bishop Charles will be staying in the community of Santa Teresa on the Monday and Tuesday at the beginning of Week 4. We appreciate the extra time he is spending in Santa Teresa and look forward to his visit. Students in M3 who hope to receive Confirmation MUST attend school to complete their preparation.
